



Library Pass Program

The Library Pass Program allows library patrons to save money on admission fees and gives families the opportunity to get out and enjoy Heritage's acres of peace, play, and education. The library pass program is only available to libraries.



What makes this season at Heritage special?

As a member of the Library Pass Program, your patrons have access to **100 acres of magnificent gardens** in the heart of historic Sandwich. Explore a diverse range of landscapes, including formal gardens, lush woodlands, and serene water features. The gardens feature a variety of plant species from flowering trees, daylilies and hostas to the internationally important collections of rhododendrons and hydrangeas – creating a visually stunning environment throughout the seasons.

Your patrons can explore **Cranberries: From Cape Cod to American Icon**, a reimagined exhibition drawn from Heritage's expanded cranberry collection—the largest museum cranberry collection in the country. They can also experience the new **Train Garden**, a permanent outdoor attraction where model trains wind through beautifully designed, Cape Cod-inspired landscapes. Visitors may immerse themselves in the **Wampanoag Wetu, Three Sisters Garden, and Mush8n** with live interpretation, or enjoy **Remembering the Revolution**, a special exhibition marking the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. And, of course, guests can revisit favorite gardens and galleries while discovering what's new across the museum.

As the second-most visited place on Cape Cod (only after the National Seashore), Heritage offers your patrons a place of relaxation and education, where they'll have experiences that are both enriching, stress-relieving, enjoyable, and good for their well-being. Enrollment in the Library Pass Program allows your patrons to enjoy this every day during the main season, at a discount.

Heritage's Library Pass Program is designed to be flexible, offering your institution the option of physical one-time-use guest tickets, a discount code for online ticket purchases, or both!

Library Pass Program Information and Guidelines

Library Pass Program Membership costs \$400 and is valid for 12 months from date of purchase.

Library Passes offer library patrons half off general admission prices for up to 6 individuals. Children 2 and under are always free and not included in this number.

Heritage is open in 2026 from Saturday, April 25 to Sunday, October 18, 10am to 5pm, 7 days a week.

An online discount code and/or physical one-time-use paper passes that you complete will be mailed - whatever works best for you and your patrons.

Only one pass may be issued per day (unless two Library Pass Program Memberships are purchased, in which case two passes can be issued per day.)
